

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Preface

In order to enhance science education among young people in Macao and enrich their knowledge in new science, the Macao Science Center plans to organize the "2024 Youth Science Video Contest" for the purpose of allowing participants to explore and learn more science knowledge, and to understand the current development and future trend of science and technology. The winning entries of the "2024 Youth Science Video Contest" may be recommended to participate in the "China Adolescents Science Video Festival" or similar competitions.

♦ Co-organizers: Macao Science Center, Macau Productivity and Technology Transfer Center, The Association for Promotion of Science and Technology of Macau, Macau Youth Science Education Association

Sponsor: Macao Foundation

♦ Eligibility: Primary 4 to tertiary students studying in Macao.

♦ Groups

Primary school groups: Primary 4 - 6 students studying in Macao upon the submission Junior secondary school groups: F1 - F3 students studying in Macao upon the submission Senior secondary school groups: S1 - S3 students studying in Macao upon the submission Tertiary school groups: Tertiary students studying in Macao upon the submission

♦ Item: Video Production

a. Primary school groups: Making a video based on the basic general knowledge at the primary stage and its theme can be chosen from Area A "Healthy Life", Area C "Natural Environment and Life" and Area D "Science and Life", or other scientific topics.

b. Secondary and tertiary school groups: Making a video with one of the themes which include "New Quality Productive Forces", "AI", "Information Security", "Sustainable Development" and "Biodiversity". Participants may also independently choose other scientific topics.

♦ Terms of Entry

- a. Entry should be submitted through an individual or a team up to five members (excluding instructors).
- b. Groups of primary and secondary schools should submit their entries in the name of their schools. Each entry can be guided by 2 instructors at most, and each instructor can guide more than one entry.



- c. Tertiary school students are allowed to organize a cross-school team. Each participating unit includes no more than 2 instructors who can instruct more than one unit.
- d. Each participating unit can submit more than one entry, provided that such entries are on different themes.
- e. Each student can take part in more than one participating unit, provided that such entries are on different themes. Where any student submits more than one entry on the same theme, all such entries will be disqualified from the contest.
- f. If the entry is recommended to "China Adolescents Science Video Festival", each student can only submit one entry to the "China Adolescents Science Video Festival".

♦ Entry Specification Requirements

- a. Category: Science Exploration Documentary (for all groups), Science Microfilm (for all groups), and Science Animation (for senior secondary and tertiary school groups only).
- b. Exploration documentaries and microfilms should be 4 8 minutes. Animations should be 2 4 minutes.
- c. All science information and knowledge on the theme should be true and correct.
- d. Entries should be original. Where materials not of the participants' original creation are used, they must be authorized and their sources must be noted.
- e. Entries in Mandarin, Cantonese, Portuguese and English are all acceptable.
- f. Entries must be subtitled.
- g. Entries can be shot and made by any equipment.
- h. Each entry should have a resolution of 1080p or above, an aspect ratio of 16:9, and a frame number of 25 per second or more.
- Entries should be in .mp4.

♦ Awards

First, second and third prizes as well as merit awards will be given in the Primary School, Junior and Senior Secondary School, and Tertiary School Groups respectively.

First Prize: One winner for each specific science theme and one to two winners for other scientific topics;

Second Prize: One to two winners for each specific science theme and one to three winners for other scientific topics;

Third Prize: One to four winners for each specific science theme and other scientific topics respectively;



Merit Award: One to five winners for each specific science theme and other scientific topics respectively;

- Subject to the decision of the adjudication panel, some awards may not be given out;
- ◆ All winners and their instructors will receive certificates;
- ◆ The first prize winners of Primary School, Junior and Senior Secondary School Groups will have the opportunity to be invited to take part in a local event or that outside Macao. Details of the event will be determined based on the actual situation and announced separately;
- ◆ The first prize winners of Tertiary School Groups will receive a voucher for a course at Macau Productivity and Technology Transfer Center.

Teamwork Spirit Award: One to ten teams;

Outstanding Organization Award: One to five school winners (for schools in Primary and Secondary School Groups only) to encourage outstanding schools in active participation, organization, division of work and performance;

Grand Prize: One school winner (for schools in Primary and Secondary School Groups only);

♦ Submission of Registration Forms

- c. Submission of Entries:
- I. Each team should submit an entry with subtitle, <u>cover and a brief introduction of the entry</u> (indicating the theme and name of the entry, team name and text description of <u>the entry</u>).
- II. Each team should complete and submit the online form and attach a cloud link to the entry, or submit a USB/CD with entry to the Ticketing Office of the Macao Science Center or Macau Productivity and Technology Transfer Center before 18:00 on October 3, 2024. No late submissions will be accepted.
- III. The submission form will be released to the team after the confirmation list has been published.

♦ Other Requirements

- a. The entry should be healthy, contain no pornography, violence, or vandalism and not infringe the relevant laws of Macao and China.
- b. Each entry must be the participant's original creation that has never been adopted by other institutions or submitted to the China Adolescents Science Video Festival. Otherwise, the participant shall bear all legal liabilities, and the organizer shall have the right to disqualify him/her from the contest and withdraw his/her award.
- c. Where the entry contains any content that the participant doesn't own the right to use, its source should be noted at the end of the entry, and a list of the sources of all such contents should be submitted to the organizer when the entry is submitted.
- d. All participants are required to comply with the *Personal Data Protection Act*. In particular, if a person's voice or image is to be recorded in the entry, prior consent of such person should be obtained (except when a street scene is filmed in a public place and no one is closed up).
- e. The organizer has the right to use all entries, regardless of whether they win or not.
- f. Winners are obliged to cooperate with the organizer to further improve or modify their entries. If you do not wish to modify your entry, please state on the registration form;
- g. The organizer reserves the right to use the entries for publicity, promotion and activities related to the contest without prior notice and remuneration to the participants;
- h. After the submission of registration forms, all those registered will be deemed to have agreed with the charter and results of the competition;
- i. The organizer reserves the right to award prizes if any entries are considered disqualified.

♦ Adjudication Panel



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- a. The adjudication panel will consist of organizer representatives and professionals and scholars in relevant fields.
- b. Subject to the decision of the adjudication panel, the winning entries may be recommended to participate in the 15th China Adolescents Science Video Festival (places will be determined according to the official rules of the 15th China Adolescents Science Video Festival).

♦ Assessment Criteria

Scientific expression 35%

Filming techniques 35%

Creativity 30%

♦ Teamwork Spirit Award

Awards will be given to teams, and teams are required to provide information on the team's division of labor, behind-the-scenes footage and insights when declaring their participations.

♦ Outstanding Organization Award

- a. Awards will be given to schools (except those belonging to tertiary institutions); and schools will be included in the assessment list if they achieve a submission rate of 80% after registration;
- b. The assessment will be based on a combination of submission rate, quality of entries and the awards rate.

♦ Grand Prize

The Prize will be given to schools to encourage those with outstanding achievements in performance.

♦ Disclaimer

- a. All submitted entries that fail to comply with the rules set out in the charter will not be assessed by the adjudication panel, without individual notices to participants. The organizer will not be responsible for any damage, loss, incompleteness, illegibility, delay or misplacement of any submission that is not caused by the organizer, without individual notices to participants;
- b. The organizer may, at its discretion, terminate the competition, modify the charter or disqualify any participant for misconduct;
- C. In the event of any disputes, the organizer reserves the right of final interpretation. The Chinese version of the charter shall prevail over the Portuguese and English versions in the event of any inconsistency.
