

Competition Details

Under teacher guidance, teams will conduct theme-based studies using LEGO[®] DUPLO[®] sets and the annual FLL Discover Set (#45831) to build solution models and create a team poster.

The poster should showcase the project process and learning outcomes. Judges will visit each team for up to 15 minutes, including 10 minutes for the team presentation and 5 minutes for judges' questions.
